



TIMELY WARNING NOTIFICATION

Incident Date: June 1, 2026 **Time of Incident:** 10:00 AM

Location: Machias, Maine

Affected Campus: University of Maine Machias

Incident Description:

Washington County law enforcement is conducting an active search for a wanted individual near the University of Maine Machias campus.

The individual is described as a male, approximately 5'6", wearing a dark Carhartt-style coat over a gray sweatshirt and jeans.

Members of the campus community are advised not to approach the individual and to call 911 immediately if he is seen.

At this time, there is no information indicating a specific threat to the University of Maine Machias community. However, students, faculty, staff, and visitors are advised to exercise caution, remain vigilant, and be aware of their surroundings while law enforcement activities continue in the area.

This Timely Warning Notification is required under the Jeanne Clery Act.

Safety Guidance

- Continue normal activities while remaining aware of your surroundings.
- If you see the individual described above, do not approach and call 911 immediately.
- If you are afraid for your safety or the safety of others, call 911 immediately.
- Do not hesitate to contact UMPD to report any information related to this incident.
